The minutes of the April Board of Directors were accepted as printed.

The Treasurers report was accepted subject to audit. A note was made that the ASRT office has a long term "Association Management" packet of information available through Mr. Mike Thayer of the ASRT.

Regional Director, Region V ASRT, Norman L. Hente provided the Board with information from the ASRT Annual Meeting (1985) regarding the House of Delegates. Norman also informed the MSRT Board that further information will be forthcoming regarding affiliates changing to a delegate system. There was discussion on funding the delegates to the ASRT House of Dele-

gates; what other affiliates in Region V are doing; ideas for funding by the region for modality delegates.

There was discussion on the MSRT bylaws and standing rules. These two documents will be updated and brought before the membership at the 1985 MSRT annual meeting for ratification.

Committee Reports:

Ways and Means: The information provided by Chairman Barbara Hente at the April Board meeting had been tabled. It was brought from the table and discussion followed. Motion 1: Debbie Hurst moved to allow the Ways and Means committee \$245.00 to order 1000 Bumper stickers for MSRT advertisement. The motion was seconded by Barbara Hente. Motion passed. Motion 2: Hurst moved to allot \$575.00 to the Ways and Means Committee for the purpose of purchasing 250 lapel pins with presentation boxes. Second by Barbara Hente. Motion passed. Debbie will look into a source she knows for purchase of the boxes. The Bumper Sticker contest entries were reviewed and the winning design came from the Colorado Society of Radiologic Technologists, designer Chairman Hente was anonymous. directed to make the purchases with the indicated changes. Each person registered at the 1985 Annual MSRT meeting will receive a free bumper sticker (additional ones will be sold at 25 cents each); the MSRT logo/lapel pins will be available at the annual meeting and through district representatives for \$3.00.

Membership Committee: The renewals are coming in with 105 renewed so far. John Desch noted that the Student Affairs Committee has had inquiries and interest from students in Farmington and Columbia.

District Representatives: lst District: President-Elect Pam Fulmer gave an oral report. They are in the process of combining the district treasury into one account. Discussion followed on districts 1,3 and 6.

3rd District: President John Bryan gave an oral report.

4th District: Gary McDaniel gave an oral report. The district had a meeting in June which was a combined dinner/social and installation of officers. He also reported that the district will have T-shirts at the annual meeting as a ways and means project for the district.

5th District: Nikki Thielmann provided a written report of the activities since May including the new district officers.

7th District: Ruby Givens gave an oral report including the new officers and the activities of our Therapy district.

Counselor Reports:

Western Counselor: Ruby Givens reported that she installed the 5th District officers 5/29/85 and has forwarded the Convention activities to the ASRT for ECE point approval.

Eastern Counselor: Gary McDaniel reported on activities approved for ECE points for the 4th and 7th Districts.

Recess for lunch 1:00 pm; reconvene 2:30.

Nominating Committee chairman Jennifer Ewert provided a written report.

Nominations were as follows: President-Elect - 5; Vice-President - 10; Secretary - 7; Treasurer - 4; Western Counselor - 8; Eastern Counselor - 7. Delegates to the ASRT House of Delegates were as follows: MSRT Affiliate Delegates - 17; Radiographer modality delegates - 8; Nuclear Medicine modality delegates - 2; Radiation Therapy modality delegates - 5; Ultrasound modality delegates - 3. The credentials of each nominee were verified.

Meeting recessed for hotel facility tour at 3:10; reconvened 3:40.

Convention 1985 report: Convention Co-Chairmen Nikki Thielmann and Connie D. Huesgen reviewed the proposed educational program. It was noted that the registration fees (total meeting; daily; member; nonmember; student; active, etc.) had not yet been specified. Nikki Thielmann noted the final registration/convention brochure for mailing to the membership should be ready to mail in about 7-10 days. BYLAW CHANGES

Chapter XIX, Section 2, states:

"Notice of such amendments shall be sent to all members of the society at least fifteen (15) days prior to the time of voting."

BYLAWS OF THE MISSOURI SOCIETY OF RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS

Chapter VIII: OFFICERS AND DELEGATES

Section 1: All officers and delegates of the Society shall be active members of the Society.

<u>Section</u> <u>2:</u> <u>Delegates shall meet all requirements of the House of Delegates and the bylaws of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists.</u>

Section $\underline{3}$: The officers of the Society shall be President, President-Elect, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and such additional officers as are recommended by the Board of Directors, and ratified by the membership.

Section $\underline{4}$: The President, President-Elect, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer, or any other officer shall be elected by a majority mail ballot. Should the membership choose another election procedure the officers shall be elected according to the method designated by the membership.

Section 5: All officers and delegates shall serve for a term of one year or until their successors have been appointed or elected. The Secretary, Treasurer and <u>Delegates</u> may be elected for a two year term upon recommendation by the Board of Directors and ratified by the membership. All officers shall surrender to their successors all records and properties belonging to the Society.

Section 6: A nominating committee of three members shall be appointed by the President within thirty (30) days following the date of the annual meeting. The committee shall satisfy itself that all candidates have the proper credentials and are willing to serve if elected.

Section 7: The report of the nominating committee shall be submitted in the manner approved by the membership consistent with the adopted voting procedure.

Section 8: Only active and life members in good standing shall be entitled to vote and hold office.

Section 9: The newly elected officers and delegates shall be installed into office under the direction of the Board of Directors.

Chapter IX: DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND DELEGATES

Section 7: Delegates shall attend the House of Delegates sessions at the annual conference of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists. They shall keep the Board of Directors and the membership fully informed of all national issues of interest.

Chapter X: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1:

- (a) The Board of Directors shall be composed of all elected officers, and delegates. At the annual meeting the retiring President shall succeed to the Board for the term of one year.

 (b) Additional directorships may be established by a ballot of the voting members of the Society. Such directors shall serve for a period of one year.
- (c) Vacancies shall be filled in accordance with Chapter XV, Section 2.

Annual Meeting
