## IN MEMORIAM

Sister Hilda Brickus, S.S.M. died March 18, 1987 in St Louis. Sister Brickus was professor emeritus at St Louis University since 1981. She had been on the faculty of the School of Allied Health Services for 26 years. She received her B.S. in Radiologic Technology in 1954. She had been supervisor of the X-ray department of the old St Mary's Infirmary and at St Joseph's Hospital in St Charles, Mo. She had been an active member of the American, Missouri and Fourth District Societies of Radiologic Technology.

Entering the Sisters of St Mary in 1946 she took her final vows in 1952. Sister Brickus was on the advisory board for the disabled and was a former chairman of the St Louis Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Enforcement Commission.

Sister Brickus was a pastoral assistant at St Mathew the Apostle Church and at St Francis Xavier College Church at her death.
