



Dues structure changes considered

There has always been some confusion in the dues structure of the Missouri Society of Radiologic Technologists and the districts within it. Currently some districts have separate dues, and do not recognize or reciprocate the technologists' membership with the state. Other districts have their own dues, but still accept the technologists' state memberships. Still others have no separate dues, but consider technologists who pay state membership fees to be members of that district.

This problem is not unique to the state of Missouri. In networking with the presidents of several other state societies, I find this is a problem with lots of other states.

One of the ways many states alleviated this problem was to have one dues structure for the entire state. All technologists who joined the state society were automatically members of their respective districts. The state, in turn, refunded a set amount of money to each district for all members who resided in that district.

The MSRT Board is looking to change our dues structure to make it more "user friendly" while still helping finance the district activities. Please complete the survey and return it prior to July 1, 1998.

If you cannot return the survey, please voice your opinion to your district representative or call any of the Board members. This issue will be discussed at the July Board of Directors meeting in Columbia, Mo. Any proposals made by the Board will not be voted on by the membership until the April 1999 Annual Conference, and would not become effective until July 1999.
