

The Missouri Society of Radiologic Technologists Student Internship Program

There will be one (1) student internship, made available to any student enrolled in a radiology program at the time of application and meets the necessary qualifications. The recipient will shadow MoSRT Board members during regular meetings of the MoSRT Board of Directors and during the MoSRT Annual Conference. The recipient will receive all privileges and financial compensation of an MoSRT Board member except the ability to vote.

Requirements:

The candidate must:

- 1. Be a student member of the MoSRT and the ASRT.
- 2. Be in good standing with a training program accredited by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists.
- 3. Be able to attend all regular meetings of the MoSRT Board of Directors.
- 4. The recipient will be encouraged to act as an ambassador for the MoSRT to the radiography programs throughout Missouri, as their schedule allows.

The recipient is required to attend the annual conference to receive their award. Note: The recipient will be notified of their selection at least two weeks in advance of the conference, and registration fees will be waived for the day the internship award is given.

Application Procedure:

- 1. Complete the application form provided on the MoSRT website (mosrt.net) no later than 11:59pm on the date of the deadline listed below. Applications submitted after the deadline will be disqualified.
- 2. The Candidate must provide two (2) accurate email addresses from recommending technologists (*registered only*) who are willing to complete a Candidate Recommendation Form. The recommenders will be contacted by the intern chair and provided a link to complete the form, which must be completed no later than two weeks after the deadline. *The recommenders must be technologists.
- 3. The candidate must submit an email, containing a copy of their Personal Essay to student internship@mosrt.org
- 4. The Program Director must submit an email, from their school address, verifying candidate's student status to student_internship@mosrt.org
- 5. All applicants <u>must</u> be current members of the MoSRT and ASRT. Upon receipt of application, membership will be verified by the membership chair.
- 6. Applicants should receive an acknowledgement email from the MoSRT website verifying application has been submitted. If no acknowledgement is received, the applicant should try contacting the Student Intern Chair to determine the status of their submission.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.



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*Remember that spam filters and firewalls can keep emails from going through. Submitting well in advance of the November 30th deadline will ensure that if there is a problem with submission, ample time will be available to remedy the situation. Submitting at the last minute may put you at risk for disqualification.

Directions for Personal Essay:

The essay must be 1000 words or less in length, double-spaced, 12-point font, and in Times New Roman font. Essays must be submitted in PDF, Microsoft Word, or Google Docs. Other word processing formats are not permitted. Essays must be written blindly. They must be free from all personal identification. Inclusion of specific names and references to personal information of your essay can put you at risk for disqualification. Examples of things NOT to include are: Program name, clinical facility name, colleague or peer names, prior employment or employer, reference to geographical location or any other information that could identify you personally. Essay content must include the following information:

1. Personal or academic achievements

How have you gone above and beyond as a student?

What leadership roles have you taken?

What personal/professional experiences have enhanced your ability to function as the student intern?

2. Career goals

How will you benefit from being selected as the student intern?

Why is it important to you to be the intern?

Why did you choose radiography as your career?

3. Professional goals

How do you plan to support the MoSRT in the future?

What impact will your selection as the student intern have on your professional development? What are your five-year goals?

How would you use your experience as the intern to support your profession?

4. Mechanics

Sentence fluency/structure Word choice/grammar Spelling/punctuation
