Proposed Bylaw Amendments

BYLAWS

In concordance with Article XIII: Amendments, bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the voting members voting at the Annual meeting. This document serves as the required notice of such amendments and it shall be sent to all members of the MoSRT at least fifteen (15) days prior to the time of the voting.

The MoSRT Board of Directors proposes the following amendments to the MoSRT Bylaws: Insertions and additions are shown as highlighted. Deletions are shown as strikethroughs.

Article VII: MoSRT DELEGATES TO THE ASRT HOUSE OF DELEGATES

Section 1: Delegates

- A. MoSRT delegates shall be elected by a plurality ballot of the voting members of the MoSRT. One delegate will be elected annually to serve a 2 year term.
- B. A tie vote will be decided by lot at a meeting of the Board of Directors prior to the end of the last business day of January.
- C. The MoSRT shall submit to ASRT the names of the two MoSRT delegates and two alternate delegates by the end of the last business day of January or the MoSRT delegate positions shall remain open until after the ASRT House of Delegates' meeting.
- D. The MoSRT has the power to remove delegates.
- E. The Board of Directors will appoint the two alternate delegates to the ASRT House of Delegates. The President should be the first alternate delegate.

Rationale: Changes in this section make wording more consistent with revised ASRT Bylaws and current practice.

In Memory of Coretta Allice Schroer, MSc, RT(R), GIA, FMoSRT



A native of St. Louis, Missouri, Coretta was a graduate of the Mallinckrodt Institute of Radiology and worked as a Radiologic Technologist for Washington University School of Medicine, Barnes Hospital. She continued her training with Washington University School of Medicine, becoming a Gastrointestinal Assistant. She served as supervisor of the Gastroenterology Lab at Barnes Hospital, later moving to Christian Hospital North East and then to Digestive Disease Specialists. Her career as an R.T. and G.I. Assistant spanned nearly forty years.

Coretta was a member of the ARRT, ASRT, MoSRT and the 4th District of the MoSRT. She served as President, Vice-President, Chairman of the Board of Directors as well as serving on many committees for the MoSRT. She was serving as Co-Chair of the By-Laws Committee and the Essay Committee at the time of her passing. In addition to being active in the MoSRT, Coretta was also active in the Society of Gastrointerology Nurses and Associates (SGNA) and the American Legion Women's Auxiliary.

From 2004-2012, Coretta served as Manager of the X-Ray Department for the Ministry of Health in the Caribbean island of Montserrat. Throughout her life she touched many people with her constant smile and infectious laugh. She never stopped planning her next goal, whether it was another position within one of her societies, a lecture at a conference, or a project for the American Legion.

During her Presidency, Coretta was instrumental in establishing the MoSRT Technologist Scholarship and was a strong proponent of continuing education and life-long learning throughout her career. The MoSRT has decided to rename the Technologist Scholarship in honor of Coretta Schroer.
